



## TO HOOK UP MOIPTV BOX

1. Plug the High Speed Internet into LAN connector in the back of the IPTV box. Then connect the RCA cables (Red, White, and Yellow) from the back of the box to the Video input of your TV set. Turn the power ON
2. The main menu will show on the screen “Broadcast Channel” for TV channels and”Radio” for radio channels. At that point, you may choose between TV or Radio channels.
3. If you choose Broadcast Channel, the choices on the screen will be “3ABN”, “3ABN Latino” and “Loma Linda”. Choose the channel you want to watch.
4. Program guide is on the right side of the channel chosen. If you want to watch a “past” program then push the right arrow to get the cursor over the program guide and arrow up or down to the program you want to watch and click PLAY.
5. If you want to watch the “current Live” program just click PLAY on the channel icon for the channel you would like to watch.
6. If you need to change the setup to wireless connection, click the yellow “SETUP” button. If the language on this page is Chinese push once the “LANG” button on the left of it on the remote control).
7. There are three areas you want to make sure it is correctly on this page. A) the first line says “Home page”. Please make sure that the address is “iptv.moiptv.net” B) the second line “LAN” should have a star next to it if they are using the wire internet connection. This is the most recommended way to connect the box because it comes pre-set and pre tested. If they want to change to a wireless internet connection, they must arrow down to the third line “WLAN” and enter their ESSID and their password. **IF YOU GET A WIRELESS SETUP CALL TELL THEM TO CALL 618-627-2300 for further assistance.** C) the fifth line is DHCP and it should have a star next to it. D) in the last line, the star should be next to the “video/S-Video” line unless the costumer has a TV set that has a component video input (Green, Blue, Red) connectors. This component connection is the best quality video but there are very few TV sets that have this kind of connection. It is recommended to leave the star next to the “Video/S-Video” because it is the most common used.
